
To find your interactive degree audit log into Panther account, navigate to Advising, Display Interactive Degree Audit (see image below).

ADDING A NEW MAJOR

Step 1: Adding the Graphic Design Support CCC is easy. Log into your panther account. Check your interactive degree audit to make sure you do not already have the program/major added to your educational plan.

To find your interactive degree audit log into Panther account, navigate to Advising, Display Interactive Degree Audit.





Image: Locating Interactive Degree Audit




Image: Locating Change Program of Study

Step 2: After checking to see you do not already have the major added, navigate to:

 - Change Program of Study.




Image: The submit button to change your program.

Step 3: You will see a page that looks like this. Obviously your page will contain information about you. Read the verbiage stating that changing your program is a big step and check that all information is correct. Only add a program when you are serious about the course of study.

- Click submit to continue.

Change Program of Study

IMPORTANT: Changing your program is an important decision. It can impact many things including scholarships, financial aid, and time to graduation. We encourage you to research your new program before requesting a change. Review the admissions and financial aid information and graduation requirements. If the program is a limited access program, make sure you understand the selection process and requirements.

Requests to Change Program of Study submitted after the Add/Drop deadline for a session will be processed for the following term. Please refer to the Academic Calendar (www.palmbeachstate.edu/academiccalendar) for add/drop deadline dates.

Also note that if you change your program, you will be required to follow the Catalog currently in effect at the time you submit your Request to Change Program of Study. We encourage you to meet with an Academic Advisor before submitting your request so that you can review course selections and your degree audit.






